KWAZULU-NATAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2008: CALL FOR PERSONS TO SERVE ON THE KWAZULU-NATAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL TRIBUNAL

In terms of Section 105 of the KwaZulu-Natal Planning and Development Act, 2008 (Act No. 6 of 2008) persons in the following categories are invited to apply to serve on the KwaZulu-Natal Planning and Development Appeal Tribunal:

- (a) advocates or attorneys who have been admitted to the High Court who have practised in South Africa for an uninterrupted period of at least five years;
- (b) persons who are registered as a professional planner or technical planner in terms of Section 13(4) of the Planning Profession Act, 2002 (Act No. 36 of 2002);
- (c) professional engineers registered in terms of Section 19(2)(a) of the Engineering Profession Act, 2000 (Act No. 46 of 2000);
- (d) professional land surveyors as defined in Section 1 of the Professional and Technical Surveyors' Act, 1984 (Act No. 40 of 1984);
- (e) professional architects registered in terms of Section 19(2) of the Architectural Profession Act, 2000 (Act No. 44 of 2000);
- (f) persons with practical experience and expertise in planning and development matters or environmental management; and
- (g) persons with practical experience and expertise in the fields of social and economic sciences.

Persons who are interested in serving on the Appeal Tribunal must lodge a written application together with a copy of their curriculum vitae and certified copies of their identity document, academic qualifications and professional registration to:
